### Introduction

Balfour Beatty is co-promoter/developer and an investor in Aberdeen Environmental Services, the concession company awarded the 30-year, £92m contract by Scottish Water in May 2000 to design, build and finance new wastewater plants in the North of Scotland and then operate them for the remainder of the period.

Balfour Beatty's shareholding is 45%.

At 31 December 2005 Balfour Beatty had invested all of its £3m of committed investment.

### Project Description

The new facilities treat sewage and wastewater from the communities of Aberdeen, Peterhead,

Fraserburgh and, in a subsequent phase, Stonehaven to the latest EC standards.

Construction of the new facilities at Aberdeen, Peterhead and Fraserburgh was completed in 2002.

Aberdeen Environmental Services procured construction of the plants through a construction contract with a construction Joint Venture, in which a Balfour Beatty Group company, Balfour Beatty Civil Engineering, had a 50% interest. Operation and maintenance of the plants is subcontracted to an experienced operator.
