PROJECT OVERVIEW

- The London Borough of Ealing and Balfour Beatty Education will form a Local Education Partnership (LEP), Future Ealing Limited, to deliver services to the two schools.
- All construction and facilities management will be carried out by Balfour Beatty.
- ICT services will be delivered in conjunction with RM Education plc, a leading supplier of ICT services and solutions to the UK education sector.
- As part of Balfour Beatty's commitment to the local community, it has pledged to target employment on the schools' sites to local people and to engage local businesses as part of the supply chain.

PROJECT SCOPE

The project covers Dormers Wells a new build secondary school which will also benefit from a 25 year maintenance and FM service and the part new, part refurbishment of the Cardinal Wiseman Secondary School. An ICT service is also provided to both schools comprising technology supply, installation and implementation, with an ongoing support-line.
